FOR the purpose of excepting-bisycles-from-using-bikeways under-sertain circumstances; defining-a-certain term; requiring-the-Motor-Vehicle-Administration-to limiting the current requirement that a kicyclist shall use a bicycle path or paved shoulder; listing situations when the limiting requirement is inapplicable; defining certain terms; requiring the Department of Transportation to promulgate certain rules and regulations; clarifying language; and generally relating to the operation of bicycles and other vehicles on roadways.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Sections 21-101 (j-1), (j-2), and (j-3) of Article - Transportation, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (As enacted by Chapter 14 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1977) be and they are herely added to read as follows:

## Article - Transportation

## 21-101.

- (J-1) "BIKEWAY" MEANS ANY TRAIL, PATH, SIDEWALK, PART OF THE ROADWAY OR SHOULDER, CF ANY OTHER TRAVELWAY SO DESIGNATED BY SIGNING, OR SIGNING AND MARKING FOR THE USE OF BICYCLES. A BIKEWAY INCLUDES A FIKE LANE.
- (J-2) "EIKE LANE" MEANS A PORTION OF A ROADWAY WHICH HAS BEEN DESIGNATED FOR PREFERENTIAL OR EXCLUSIVE USE BY BICYCLES. IT IS DISTINGUISHED FROM THE PORTION OF THE BOADWAY FOR MOTOR VEHICULAR TRAFFIC EY A FAINT STRIPE, CURB OR OTHER SIMILAR DEVICE.
- (J-3) "SHOULDER" MEANS THAT PORTION OF A HIGHWAY CONTIGUOUS WITH THE ROADWAY FOR THE ACCOMODATION OF STOPPED VEHICLES, FOR EMERGENCY USE, AND FOR THE LATERAL SUPPORT OF THE BASE AND SURFACE COURSES OF THE ROADWAY.
