Transportation, of the Annotated Ccde of Maryland (As enacted by Chapter 14 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1977) be and they are hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

## Article - Transportation

(b) A vehicle shall be driven as nearly as practicable entirely within a single lane and may not be moved from that lane OR MOVED FROM A SHOULDER OR BIKEWAY INTO A LANE until the driver has determined that it is safe to do so.

## (a) A person may not:

(2) Turn a vehicle to enter a private road or driveway or otherwise turn a vehicle from a direct course or move it right or left on a roadway[,] OR FROM A SHOULDER OR BIKEWAY ONTO A ROADWAY, unless the movement can be made with reasonable safety; or

- (I) WHEN OVERTAKING AND PASSING ANOTHER BICYCLE, PEDESTRIAN, OR OTHER VEHICLE WITHIN THE BIKEWAY BIKE LANE OR SHOULDER IF THE OVERTAKING AND PASSING CANNOT BE DONE SAFELY WITHIN THE BIKEWAY BIKE LANE OR SHOULDER;
- (II) WHEN PREPARING FOR A LEFT TURN AT AN INTERSECTION OR INTO AN ALLEY, PRIVATE ROAD, OR DRIVEWAY; OR
- (III) WHEN REASONAELY NECESSARY TO LEAVE THE BIKEWAY BIKE LANE OR SHOULDER TO AVOID DEBRIS OR OTHER HAZARDOUS CONDITION.
- (2) A PERSON OPERATING A BICYCLE MAY NOT LEAVE A BIKEWAY BIKE LANE OR SHOULDER UNTIL THE MOVEMENT CAN BE MADE WITH REASONABLE SAFETY AND THEN ONLY AFTER GIVING AN APPROPRIATE SIGNAL.
