- (2) "CRIME" MEANS AN ACT COMMITTED BY ANY PERSON IN THE STATE OF MARYLAND WHICH WOULD CONSTITUTE A CRIME AS DEFINED IN ARTICLE 27 OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND OR AT COMMON LAW. HOWEVER, AN ACT INVCLVING THE OPERATION OF A MOTOR VEHICLE WHICH RESULIS IN INJURY DOES NOT CONSTITUTE A CRIME FOR THE PURPOSE OF THIS APTICLE UNLESS THE INJURIES WEPE INTENTIONALLY INFLICTED THROUGH THE USE OF A VEHICLE.
- (3) "DEFENDANT" MEANS ANY PERSON WHO HAS BEEN FOUND GUILTY OF A CRIME OF ANY PERSON WHOSE PLEA OF NOLO CONTENDERE TO A CRIME HAS BEEN ACCEPTED BY THE COURT.
- (4) "DIVISION" MEANS DIVISION OF PAROLE AND PROBATION.
 - (5) "JUDGE" MEANS A JUIGE OF A COURT.
- (6) "PROPERTY" MEANS BOTH REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY.
 - (B) UPON CONVICTION FOR A CRIME WHERE FROPERTY OF ANOTHER HAS BEEN STOLEN, CONVERTED, UNLAWFULLY OBTAINED, OR ITS VALUE SUBSTANTIALLY DECREASED AS A DIRECT RESULT OF THE CRIME, OR WHERE THE VICTIM SUFFERED PERSONAL PHYSICAL—OR MENTAL—INJURY—OR ACTUAL MEDICAL EXPENSES, DIRECT OUT OF POCKET LOSSES, OF LOSS OF EARNING OR SUPPORT AS A DIRECT RESULT OF THE CFIME, THE COURT MAY ENTER—A—JUDGMENT—AND—GRDER—FOR CFDER THE DEFENDANT TO MAKE RESTITUTION IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER PENALTY PROVIDED FOR THE COMMISSION OF THE CRIME.
 - (C) WHEN A JUDGMENT OR AN ORDER OF RESTITUTION HAS BEEN ENTERED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (B), COMPLIANCE WITH THE JUDGMENT OR ORDER MAY BE MADE AS A SENTENCE OF CONDITION OF FROBATION OF PAROLE.
 - (D) (1) RESTITUTION IS MADE BY THE DEFENDANT TO THE DIVISION OF PAROLE AND PROBATION OF THE COUNTY IN WHICH HE WAS CONVICTED UNDER THE TEFMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE JUDGMENT AND ORDER FOR RESTITUTION.
 - (2) THE DIVISION SHALL KEEP RECORDS OF ANY PAYMENTS OR RETURN OF FROPERTY IN SATISFACTION OF THE JUDGMENT AND ORDER.
 - (3) THE DIVISION SHALL FORWARD ANY PROPERTY OR PAYMENTS TO THE VICTIM OF THE CRIME.
 - (4) THE DIVISION MAY ASSESS ADDITIONAL FEES NOT TO EXCEED 2 PERCENT OF THE JUDGMENT AMOUNT OF THE ORDER TO PAY FOR ADMINISTRATIVE COSIS OF COLLECTING PAYMENTS OR PROPERTY. THESE FEES SHALL BE PAID BY THE DEFENDANT.
 - (E) WHEN A DEFENDANT FAILS TO MAKE RESTITUTION AS ORDERED, THE DIVISION SHALL NOTIFY THE COURT. THE COURT
