This land acquisition shall be subject to prior approval by the County Commissioners for Prince George's County] SCHOOL SITES AND OTHER PUBLIC USES IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, PROVIDED THAT LAND MAY NOT BE ACQUIRED FOR ANY PROJECT THAT IS WITHIN THE CAPITAL BUDGET OF THE APPROVED CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY. PROVISION ALSO MAY BE MADE FOR ACQUISITION OF LANDS IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY NEEDED FOR STATE HIGHWAYS AND STATE STREETS OR ROADS THAT ARE SHOWN ON ADOPTED AND APPROVED MASTER PLANS AND ARE INCLUDED IN THE MARYLAND TWENTY-YEAR HIGHWAY NEEDS STUDY. ALL LAND ACQUISITIONS SHALL BE SUBJECT TO ~~PRIOR APPROVAL BY FORMAL RESOLUTION OF THE DISTRICT COUNCIL OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, AFTER SUCH RESOLUTION HAS BEEN REVIEWED AND COMMENTED ON BY THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE.~~ PASSAGE OF AN ORDINANCE BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL.
