of resubdivided lots to the character of lots within the existing subdivision with respect to area, frontage, and alignment to existing lots and streets; (10) control of subdivision or building (except for agricultural or recreational purposes) in flood plain areas or streams and drainage courses, and on unsafe land areas; (11) preservation of outstanding natural or cultural features and historic sites or structures; or (12) other benefits to the health—+— __ comfort, safety or welfare of the present and future population of the regional district.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.
