

(a) The Board may refuse to grant a license to an applicant, may reprimand a licensee or place him on probation, or it may suspend or revoke a license on any of the following grounds:

(6) The practice of physical therapy other than under the written or verbal order of a physician licensed to practice medicine and surgery, [or] a licensed dentist, OR A LICENSED PODIATRIST;

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.

(House Bill 1881)

AN ACT concerning

Anne Arundel County - Alcoholic Beverages

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 46 (d) of Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1976 Replacement Volume and 1976 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

(d) [No] AN alcoholic beverage license in Anne Arundel County may NOT be renewed [and/]cr transferred unless the owner [or owners thereof have] OF IT HAS actively engaged in the sale of alcoholic beverages as
