(b) (4) (I) THE COMPOSITION OF THE COUNCIL, THE SELECTION OF MEMBERS, AND THE ADMINISTRATION AND FUNCTIONING OF THE COUNCIL SHALL CONFORM TO THE STANDARDS OF THE FEDERAL DRUG ABUSE OFFICE AND TREATMENT ACT OF 1972, PUBLIC LAW 92 255 COMPREHENSIVE ALCCHOL ABUSE AND ALCOHOLISM PREVENTION, TREATMENT, AND REHABILITATION ACT OF 1970, PUBLIC LAW 91-616, AND TO ANY RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED OR ADOPTED FURSUANT TO THE ACT.

(II) THIS PARAGRAPH DOES NOT REQUIRE THE DISBANCING OF THE PRESENT COUNCIL AND THE IMMEDIATE APPOINTMENT OF NEW MEMBERS. HOWEVER, ANY APPOINTMENTS UNDER THIS ACT SHALL BE MADE SO AS TO BRING THE COUNCIL INTO COMPLIANCE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE WITH REGARD TO FEDERAL MEMBERSHIP STANDARDS.
