Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages
Section 96(a)
Annotated Code of Maryland
(1976 Replacement Volume and 1976 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 96(a) of Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1976 Replacement Volume and 1976 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

96.

(a) In Charles County, notwithstanding any other provisions of this subtitle, the hours of sale for alcoholic beverages shall be as follows:

- (1) Monday, 6 a.m. to Tuesday, 2 a.m.
- (2) Tuesday, 6 a.m. to Wednesday, 2 a.m.
- (3) Wednesday, 6 a.m. to Thursday, 2 a.m.
- (4) Thursday, 6 a.m. to Friday, 2 a.m.
- (5) Friday, 6 a.m. to Saturday, 2 a.m.
- (6) Saturday, 6 a.m. to Sunday, 2 a.m.
- (7) Sunday, 6 a.m. to Sunday, midnight[, for beer and light wine only].
- [(8) Sunday, noon to Sunday, midnight, for liquor.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.

CHAPTER 620

(House Bill 2012)

AN ACT concerning
