

## (C) SALARY.

THE ADMINISTRATOR IS ENTITLED TO THE SALARY PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from Art. 41, §207C(a) - except for the first sentence of that section, which now appears as §6-201 of this subtitle.

The provisions of present §207C(a) that deal with the "incumbent Executive Director of the Maryland Port Authority as of June 30, 1971" are deleted as now obsolete.

Present §207C (k) and (e) are deleted as obsolete. Present §207C(c) and (d) now appear in §6-213 of this subtitle.

## (A) GENERAL EXERCISE OF POWERS AND DUTIES.

THE EXERCISE OF THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE ADMINISTRATION IS SUBJECT TO THE AUTHORITY OF THE SECRETARY AND, WHERE APPLICABLE, THE MARYLAND TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY.
