~~(C) EVERY RESTAURANT OPERATOR SHALL~~ POST AND MAINTAIN IN A CONSPICUOUS PLACE IN THE EVERY RESTAURANT A DIAGRAM GIVING CLEAR AND ILLUSTRATIVE DIRECTIONS ON THE USE OF THE HEIMLICH MANEUVER MANUAL MANEUVERS TO ASSIST CHOKING VICTIMS.

~~(D) A RESTAURANT OPERATOR SHALL COMPLETE A COURSE OF INSTRUCTION APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE IN UTILIZING THE HEIMLICH MANEUVER. UPON COMPLETION OF THE COURSE, THE RESTAURANT OPERATOR WITHIN A REASONABLE TIME SHALL TRAIN ALL EMPLOYEES IN THE METHOD.~~

~~(E) (C)~~ A PERSON WHO APPLIES THE ~~HEIMLICH MANEUVER~~ THESE MANEUVERS TO REMOVE FOOD LODGED IN THE THROAT OF ANOTHER IS LIABLE ONLY IF HIS ACTIONS AMOUNT TO GROSS NEGLIGENCE.

~~(F) A RESTAURANT OPERATOR WHO VIOLATES THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND UPON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$50.~~
