CHAPTER 635

(Senate Bill 641)

AN ACT concerning

Staff of Public Service Commission

FOR the purpose of authorizing requiring the Public Service Commission to hire certain personnel en-a permanent basis—or—on—a—ease-ky-case—kasis,—as needed; and providing that counsel to the Commission staff are appointed by and-serve-at-the-pleasure-of the Commission.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 16(a) of Article 78 - Public Service Commission Law, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1975 Replacement Volume and 1976 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 78 - Public Service Commission Law

16.

(a) The annual budget shall provide sufficient funds for the Commission to hire, develop, and organize a staff to perform its functions under this Article, including but not limited to the analysis of all data submitted to the Commission and the preparation of a staff position in matters pending before the Commission. [The staff shall include but not be limited to] THE COMMISSION MAY ELTHER HIRE FULL TIME PERMANENT—EMPLOYEES OR—INDEPENDENT—EXPERTS—ON—A—CASE—BY—CASE—BASIS,—AS NEEDED,—IN SUCH POSITIONS—AS SHALL HIRE economists; cost of capital experts; rate design experts; accountants; engineers; transportation specialists; lawyers; and any other experts deemed necessary to meet the needs of the Commission; OR, AS REQUIRED, RETAIN SUCH PERSONS ON A CASE BY CASE BASIS. The Commission may, from time to time, retain additional experts as required for a
