~~(B) (1) THE COUNCIL CONSISTS OF 25 MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR.~~

(B) (1) THE COUNCIL SHALL CONSIST OF 30 MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR. COUNCIL MEMBERSHIP SHALL BE REDUCED TO 25 MEMBERS BY JULY 1, 1980. THIS REDUCTION SHALL BE ACCOMPLISHED BY REDUCING THE NUMBER OF REGULARLY SCHEDULED COUNCIL APPOINTMENTS (OR REAPPOINTMENTS) BY 2 ON JULY 1, 1978 AND 1979 AND BY 1 ON JULY 1, 1980.

(2) THE MEMBERSHIP ~~SHALL~~ MAY INCLUDE INDIVIDUALS WHO:

(I) REPRESENT, AND ARE FAMILIAR WITH, THE VOCATIONAL NEEDS AND PROBLEMS OF MANAGEMENT IN THE STATE;

(II) REPRESENT, AND ARE FAMILIAR WITH, THE VOCATIONAL NEEDS AND PROBLEMS OF ORGANIZED LABOR IN THE STATE;

(III) REPRESENT, AND ARE FAMILIAR WITH, THE VOCATIONAL NEEDS AND PROBLEMS OF AGRICULTURE IN THE STATE;

(IV) REPRESENT STATE INDUSTRIAL AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AGENCIES;

(V) REPRESENT COMMUNITY AND JUNIOR COLLEGES;

(VI) REPRESENT OTHER INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION, AREA VOCATIONAL SCHOOLS, TECHNICAL INSTITUTES, AND POSTSECONDARY AGENCIES OR INSTITUTIONS THAT PROVIDE PROGRAMS OF VOCATIONAL OR TECHNICAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING;

(VII) HAVE SPECIAL KNOWLEDGE, EXPERIENCE, OR QUALIFICATIONS WITH RESPECT TO VOCATIONAL EDUCATION BUT ARE NOT INVOLVED IN THE ADMINISTRATION OF STATE OR LOCAL VOCATIONAL EDUCATION PROGRAMS;

(VIII) REPRESENT, AND ARE FAMILIAR WITH, PUBLIC PROGRAMS OF VOCATIONAL EDUCATION IN COMPREHENSIVE SECONDARY SCHOOLS;

(IX) REPRESENT, AND ARE FAMILIAR WITH, NONPROFIT PRIVATE SCHOOLS;
