CHAPTER 642

(Senate Bill 1196)

AN ACT concerning

Baltimore County - Bailiff's Salary

FOR the purpose of altering the salary of the kailiff of the Orphans' Court of Baltimore County; and clarifying language.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

The Public Local Laws of Baltimore County Section 7-67 Article 3 - Public Local Laws of Maryland (1968 Edition and 1975 Supplement, as amended)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 7-67 of the Public Local Laws of Baltimore County being Article 3 of the Public Local Laws of Maryland (1968 Edition and 1975 Surplement, as amended) be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 3

7-67.

The judges of orphans court may appoint a haliff, who shall attend each sitting of the court and perform such duties as the court and register of wills [may direct, and shall be paid an] DIRECTS. THE annual salary of [four thousand dollars] THE BAILLIFF IS \$6000.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.
