(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED:

(2) "RESTAURANT" MEANS EVERY FACILITY THAT PREPARES FOOD AND PROVIDES SEATING CAPACITY FOR PATRONS.

(3) "SECRETARY" MEANS THE SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE.

(B) THE SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE SHALL IMPLEMENT A PROGRAM TO POST AND MAINTAIN IN EVERY RESTAURANT A DIAGRAM GIVING CLEAR AND ILLUSTRATIVE DIRECTIONS ON THE USE OF MANUAL MANEUVERS TO ASSIST CHOKING VICTIMS.

(C) A PERSON WHO APPLIES THESE MANEUVERS TO REMOVE FOOD LODGED IN THE THROAT OF ANOTHER IS LIABLE ONLY IF HIS ACTIONS AMOUNT TO GROSS NEGLIGENCE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.
