with the standard travel regulations.

- (E) The exercise or performance of all powers, authority, duties, and functions vested in the Board by the provisions of this subtitle shall be subject to the power and authority of the Secretary of Licensing and Regulation as set forth in Article 41 of this Code, or elsewhere in the laws of this State.
- (F) All moneys collected under this subtitle shall be paid over to the Treasurer and shall become general funds of the State. Such moneys shall thereafter be disbursed by the Comptroller only pursuant to an appropriation made in accordance with §§ 32 and 52 of Article 3 of the Constitution or pursuant to the provisions of §§ 1 through 15, inclusive, of Article 15A, of this Code, title "Budget and Fiscal Planning," as amended from time to time.

(b) The annual fee for a license for any horse riding stable [where five or less horses are maintained for rental purposes shall be \$10. All other annual license fees for horse riding stables shall be] IS \$25. The annual inspection fee is \$25.
