(B) THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION DO NOT APPLY TO POLICIES ISSUED, SOLD OR DELIVERED IN THIS STATE TO INSURE VEHICLES AS DEFINED IN SECTION 11-165 OF THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.

CHAPTER 656

(House Bill 1288)

AN ACT concerning

Civil Immunity — Taking Blcod Samples for the Purpose of Criminal Investigation

FOR the purpose of providing that certain persons are immune from civil liability for the act of complying with a request or directive of certain officers to take blood samples and make tests of it under certain circumstances; specifying that this immunity does not extend to protect a person from taking blood in a negligent or reckless manner; and changing the style of expression of language in the Annotated Code of Maryland.
