~~(2) THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE FUNDING FORMULA ADMINISTERED PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPH (1) SHALL PROVIDE THAT IF THE TOTAL STATE SHARE OF CURRENT EXPENSES, AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTIONS (A) AND (B) AND SECTION 7B, EXCEEDS THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED, THE AMOUNTS TO BE PAID TO EACH COMMUNITY COLLEGE SHALL BE PAID ON A PROPORTIONATE BASIS. IF THE TOTAL STATE SHARE OF CURRENT EXPENSES IS LESS THAN THE APPROPRIATION, THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE APPROPRIATION AND THAT TOTAL SHALL REVERT TO THE STATE.~~

~~(3) THE ENROLLMENT PROJECTION PROVIDED FOR IN THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT A COMMUNITY COLLEGE FROM ADMITTING ADDITIONAL STUDENTS BEYOND ANY SUCH PROJECTION, NOR DOES IT PROHIBIT A COUNTY (OR BALTIMORE CITY) GOVERNING BODY FROM AUTHORIZING ADDITIONAL LOCAL FUNDS FOR SUCH ADDITIONAL STUDENTS SO ADMITTED.~~

Notwithstanding [any other] THE provisions of [the law to the contrary] SECTION 7(A) AND (B), for the purpose of computing the shares of the State, local subdivisions, and students for the support of Chesapeake College and Garrett [County] Community College the [statutory base shall be \$2,365 per full-time equivalent student. The] State shall pay a 55 percent share, the student shall pay a 13 percent share, and the local subdivision shall pay a 32 percent share, with the State's share not to exceed the sum of [\$1,300] \$1,485 for each full-time equivalent student.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977 contingent upon the taking effect of Chapter ___ of the Acts of 1977 (H.B. ___ or S.B. ___) which provides that Lottery Revenues collected in Fiscal year 1978 shall be placed in the General Fund for Fiscal Year 1978, and if Chapter ___ does not become effective, this Act shall be null and void without the necessity of further action by the General Assembly.
