- 6-212. CONFLICTS OF INTEREST PROHIBITED.
 - (A) PROHIBITIONS.
 - AN AGENT OR EMPLOYEE OF THE ADMINISTRATION MAY NOT:
 - (1) CONTRACT WITH THE ADMINISTRATION;
- (2) HAVE ANY DIRECT OR INDIFFECT INTEREST IN A CONTRACT WITH THE ADMINISTRATION; OR
- (3) HAVE ANY DIRECT OR INDIRECT INTEREST IN THE SALE OR PURCHASE BY THE ADMINISTRATION OF ANY PROPERTY.
 - (B) PENALTIES.

ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 1 YEAR OR BOTH.
