- OF LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE A LIST OF ALL REFORTS AND PUBLICATIONS ISSUED BY THEM WHICH AFE FITHER FEQUIRED BY LAW OR INTENDED BY THEM FOR DISTRIBUTION TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL COMFILE AND MAINTAIN A LIST OF ALL THESE REFORTS AND FUBLICATIONS AND SHALL PERIODICALLY FORWARD THESE LISTS TO THE MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FOR THE PURFOSE OF FURNISHING THEM A REFERENCE SOURCE FROM WHICH THEY MAY REQUEST REPORTS AND PUBLICATIONS FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF LEGISLATIVE REPERENCE. IN ADDITION, THE DEPARTMENT OF LEGISLATIVE REPERENCE. IN ADDITION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PRESERVE, CATALOGUE, AND INDEX ALL REPORTS AND PUBLICATIONS FILED WITH OR SUBMITTED TO THE DEPARTMENT BY THE VARIOUS STATE AGENCIES AND OFFICIALS IN COMPLIANCE WITH FITHER THE REQUIREMENT OF SECTION 53 OF THIS ARTICLE OR THE REQUIREMENT OF SECTION 53 OF THIS ARTICLE OR THE REQUIREMENTS OF NUMEROUS SECTIONS FILSEWHERE IN THE CODE; AND MAY SELECT, PRESERVE, CATALOGUE, AND INDEX OTHER REPORTS AND PUBLICATIONS IT DEEMS NECESSARY.
- (E) THE DEPARTMENT OF LEGISLATIVE BEFERENCE SHALL ACCEPT REQUESTS FOR REPORTS AND PUBLICATIONS FROM MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND SHALL CHTAIN THOSE MATERIALS FROM THE APPROPRIATE AGENCY AND DISTRIBUTE THEM TO THE MEMBERS.
- (E) (F) ANY STATE AGENCY OR OFFICIAL REQUIRED TO SUBMIT AN ANNUAL OR PERIODIC REFORT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY SHALL COMPLY WITH THIS REFCRTING REQUIREMENT BY SUBMITTING FIVE COPIES OF EACH REPORT TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE. THE EXECUTIVE AGENCY OR OFFICIAL, UPON THE REQUEST OF A MEMBER OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, SHALL SUBSECUENTLY FORWARD A COPY OR COPIES OF THE REPORT TO THE REQUESTING LEGISLATOR. ADDITIONAL COPIES SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED TO MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FROCEDURE SET FORTH IN THIS SECTION.
- -{F} STATE AGENCIES MAY NOT SEND PUBLISHED MATERIAL OTHER THAN CORRESPONDENCE TO MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY THOSE AGENCIES SHALL SEND ANY MATERIALS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LEGISLATIVE FREERINGE FOR CATALOGING, FILING, AND INDEXING. THE AGENCIES MAY SEND LISTS OF AVAILABLE MATERIALS TO MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.
- 46) GTHER THAN CORRESPONDENCE, NO FUEL ICATIONS
 SHALL BE SENT BY A STATE AGENCY DIRECTLY TO MEMBERS OF
 THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY UNLESS REQUESTED BY AN INDIVIDUAL
 LEGISLATOR, A STANDING COMMITTEE, OR THE LEGISLATIVE
 FOLICY COMMITTEE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.
