- A-MEMBER OF THE BAR-OF-ANY-STATE, GR-THE-DISTRICT-OF GGLUMBIA ADMITTED TO PRACTICE LAW IN THE STATE OF MARYLAND.
- (C) THE STATE'S ATTORNEYS' CCORDINATOR SHALL RECEIVE THE SALARY PROVIDED IN THE STATE EUGGET. THE STATE'S ATTORNEYS' COORDINATOR CCORDINATION COUNCIL SHALL, BEGINNING WITH THE FISCAL YEAR 1979, PREPARE AND SUBMIT TO THE GOVERNOR A CONSOLIDATED BUDGET FOR HIS THE OFFICE.
- (D) THE STATE'S ATTORNEYS' CCORDINATOR SHALL DEVOTE FULL TIME TO HIS OFFICIAL DUTIES AND MAY NOT ENGAGE IN THE PRIVATE PRACTICE OF LAW.
- 41B. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES.
- (A) THE STATE'S ATTORNEYS' COORDINATOR HAS THE FCLLOWING DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- (2) TO PROVIDE AND CCORDINATE CONTINUING LEGAL EDUCATION PROGRAMS AND SERVICES FOR STATE'S ATTORNEYS AND THEIR PROFESSIONAL STAFFS INCLUDING LEGAL RESEARCH, TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE, TECHNICAL AND PROFESSIONAL PUBLICATIONS, COMPILING AND DISSEMINATING INFORMATION AND ADVISE STATE'S ATTORNEYS OF CURRENT DEVELOPMENTS AND CHANGES IN THE CRIMINAL LAW AND THE ADMINISTRATION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE RELATIVE IC THE DUTIES OF THEIR OFFICE:
- (3) WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE COUNCIL, TO ESTABLISH AND IMPLEMENT UNIFORM REFORTING PROCEDURES FOR THE STATE'S ATTORNEYS AND THEIR PROFESSIONAL STAFFS TO MAINTAIN AND PROVIDE STATISTICAL DATA AND INFORMATION RELATIVE TO PROSECUTORIAL FUNCTIONS AND STANDARDS IN THEIR OFFICE;
- (4) TC-COOPERATE-WITE-CTHER-PUELIG-AND PRIVATE-AGINGIES-AND-ORGANIZATIONS-RELATIVE-TO-THE ADMINISTRATION-AND-COORDINATION-OF-CRIMINAL-JUSTICE;
