- 1-102. CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE WITH WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION LAW.
 - (A) "EMPLOYER" DEFINED.

IN THIS SECTION, "EMPLOYER" HAS THE SAME MEANING AS UNDER THE STATE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION LAWS.

(B) COMPLIANCE CERTIFICATE REQUIRED.

BEFORE ANY LICENSE OR PERMIT IS ISSUED UNDER THIS ARTICLE TO AN EMPLOYER TO ENGAGE IN AN ACTIVITY IN WHICH THE EMPLOYER MAY EMPLOY ANY INDIVIDUAL, THE EMPLOYER SHALL FILE WITH THE ISSUING AUTHORITY:

- (1) A CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE WITH THE STATE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION LAWS: OR
- (2) A WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION INSURANCE POLICY OR BINDER NUMBER.
 - REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language that combines Art. 1A, §6-605, and Art. 66 1/2, §5-901.

Art. 101, §31A of the Code sets forth the procedure for obtaining a certificate of compliance under this section.

TITLE 2. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.

SUBTITLE 1. ORGANIZATION AND GENERAL AUTHORITY OF THE DEPARTMENT.

2-101. DEPARTMENT ESTABLISHED.

THERE IS A DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, ESTABLISHED AS A PRINCIPAL DEPARTMENT OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT.
