

CHAPTER 720

(Senate Bill 566)

AN ACT concerning

Gambling - Seized Money

FOR the purpose of providing the procedure for forfeiture or return of moneys seized in connection with an arrest for gambling; clarifying certain jurisdictional matters; renumbering as appropriate; and dealing generally with disposition of moneys seized in gambling arrests.
