~~(g) IN CALVERT COUNTY, FROM COUNTY TAXATION ONLY, REAL PROPERTY KNOWN AS THE CALVERT COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS AND LOCATED IN THE SECOND ELECTION DISTRICT OF CALVERT COUNTY, AS LONG AS THE PROPERTY IS USED FOR THE CALVERT COUNTY FAIR. PROVIDED THAT ONLY THE PORTION OF THIS PROPERTY AND BUILDINGS THAT IS ACTUALLY USED FOR THE CALVERT COUNTY FAIR SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM TAXATION.~~
