SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That new Sections 52 through 55, inclusive, to be under the new subtitle "State Employee Grievance Procedures", be and they are hereby added to Article 64A - Merit System, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1972 Replacement Volume and 1976 Supplement) to read as follows:

Article 64A - Merit System

STATE EMPLOYEE GRIEVANCE FROCEDURES

52.

- (A) AS USED IN THIS SUBTITLE, THE FOILOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
- (B) "GRIEVANCE" MEANS ANY CAUSE OF COMPLAINT UNLESS OTHERWISE PROVIDED FOR UNDER THIS ARTICLE ARISING BETWEEN AN EMPLOYEE AND HIS EMPLOYER OVER THE INTERPRETATION AND APPLICATION OF STATE EMPLOYEE PERSONNEL RULES, REGULATIONS, POLICIES OR ANY OTHER RULES, REGULATIONS OR POLICIES OVER WHICH MANAGEMENT HAS CONTROL.
- (C) "WORK DAY" MEANS, ANY DAY FROM MCNDAY THROUGH FRIDAY, REGARDLESS OF WEEKEND WORK OR MIDWEEK DAYS OFF.

(A) ANY EMPLOYEE OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND CLASSIFIED OR UNCLASSIFIED, OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT, UNLESS EXCEPTED BY SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, MAY PRESENT ANY GRIEVANCE WHICH HE MAY
