- (F) IN THE CASE OF A DISCIPLINARY SUSPENSION, EXCEPT A SUSPENSION PENDING THE FESCLUTION OF CHARGES WHICH, IF PROVED, WOULD RESULT IN THE DISMISSAL OF AN EMPLOYEE:
- (1) THE EMPLOYEE AND OR HIS DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE MAY SUBMIT A WEITTEN AFPEAL OF A DISCIPLINARY SUSPENSION TO THE SECRETARY OF PERSONNEL WITHIN FIVE DAYS IN ACCORDANCE WITH EXISTING RULES REGULATIONS; OR
- (2) THE EMPLOYEE AND CR HIS CESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE MAY APPEAL THE SUSPENSION WITHIN THREE DAYS, TO THE APPOINTING AUTHORITY OR HIS CESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE. IN SUCH EVENT, THE AFFOINTING AUTHORITY OR HIS DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE MUST HEAR THE CASE WITHIN THREE DAYS FROM THE RECEIPT OF THE WRITTEN APPEAL. IF THE APPEAL GOES UNHEARD OR UNANSWERED AS A RESULT OF MANAGEMENT DELAY, THE EMPLOYEE SHALL BE REINSTATED WITH FULL EACK PAY.
- (3) IN THE EVENT THAT THE EMPICYEE CHOOSES TO APPEAL TO THE APPOINTING AUTHORITY OR HIS DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE, ANY FURTHER APPEALS MUST PROCEED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE GRIEVANCE PROCECURE SET FORTH IN SECTION 54 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- (4) ANY SUSPENSION OF AN EMPLOYEE MUST BEGIN NOT LATER THAN SHALL BEGIN NOT LATER THAN TWO DAYS AFTER THE CLOSE OF THE EMPLOYEE'S NEXT SHIFT FOLLOWING THE ALLEGED INFRACTION OR KNOWLEDGE OF THE ALLEGED INFRACTION. ALL SUSPENSION DAYS MUST BE CONSECUTIVE.
- THE ONLY EXCEPTIONS TO SUBSECTION (F) (4)

 ARE ACTIONS TAKEN BY THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND

 MARYLAND STATE POLICE ACCIDENT REVIEW EDARDS. EACH OF

 THESE BOARDS HAS 20 DAYS FOR REVIEW AND THEN MUST COMPLY

 WITH SUBSECTION (F) (4) OF THIS SECTION.
- GRIEVANCE AN EMPLOYEE DESIGNATED AS A GRIEVANCE PROCEDURE REPRESENTATIVE SHALL NOT SUFFER ANY LOSS OF PAY FOR INVESTIGATING, PROCESSING OR TESTIFYING IN ANY STEP OF THE GRIEVANCE PROCEDURE. RELEASE TIME FROM NORMAL WORK SCHEDULES IS TO BE GRANTED ALL WITNESSES TO ATTEND GRIEVANCE HEARINGS. EXPENSES INCURRED IN CONNECTION WITH ATTENDANCE BY EMPLOYEES AT GRIEVANCE HEARINGS WILL BE BORNE BY THE EMPLOYEE'S AGENCY.
- (H) THE SECRETARY OF EACH DEFARTMENT SHALL SUBMIT TO THE SECRETARY OF PERSONNEL A LIST OF THOSE PERSONS DESIGNATED TO REPRESENT HIM AT EACH STEF OF THE GRIEVANCE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.
