[(e)] (F) Any money received from [packers' and] dealers' licenses shall be paid over to the Comptroller of the treasury to be credited to the Fisheries Research and Development Fund.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.
