CHAPTER 751

(Senate Bill 1132)

AN ACT concerning

Carroll County - Maintenance ~~Master~~ Plumber

FOR the purpose of creating the position of "maintenance ~~master~~ plumber" for Carroll County and requiring that a person or firm ~~doing its own engaged in~~ maintenance ~~or plumbing work be licensed repairs in~~ Carroll County ~~must have a maintenance licensed plumber on the staff~~; providing for examination of applicants ~~and issuance of certificates; and generally relating to the plumbing regulation ;~~ charging of fees and issuance of certificates.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That new Section 325C (C) be and it is hereby added to Article 43 - Health, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1971 Replacement Volume and 1976 Supplement) to read as follows:

Article 43 - Health

325C.

(C) (1) FOR CARROLL COUNTY, THE TERM "MAINTENANCE ~~MASTER~~ PLUMBER" AS USED IN THIS TITLE, MEANS ANY PERSON, FIRM OR CORPORATION ENGAGED IN THE WORK OF MAINTAINING, SERVICING, OR REPAIRING ANY KIND ~~OF EXISTING PLUMBING INSTALLATION. THE REGULATIONS SHALL REQUIRE THAT ANY PERSON, FIRM, OR CORPORATION DOING ITS OWN MAINTENANCE, SERVICE, OR REPAIRS ON ITS OWN PREMISES IN CARROLL COUNTY MUST HAVE AT LEAST ONE REPRESENTATIVE LICENSED AS A MAINTENANCE MASTER PLUMBER WHO IS RESPONSIBLE TO THE BOARD FOR ALL EMPLOYEES UNDER HIS SUPERVISION.
