SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That subject to the provisions of Section 2 herein and for the sole purpose of providing for the referendum therein required, this Act shall take effect on July-June 1, 1977.

CHAPTER 751

(Senate Bill 1132)

AN ACT concerning

Carroll County - Maintenance Master Plumber

FOR the purpose of creating the position of "maintenance master plumber" for Carroll County and requiring that a person or firm deing—its—eun engaged in maintenance of plumbing work be licensed fepairs—in Carroll—County—must—have—a—maintenance—licensed plumber—on—the—staff; providing for examination of applicants and—issuance—of—certificates;—and generally relating—to—the—plumbing—regulation; charging of fees and issuance of certificates.

(C) (1) FOR CARROLL COUNTY, THE TERM "MAINTENANCE MASTER PLUMBER" AS USED IN THIS TITLE, MEANS ANY PERSON, FIRM OR CORPORATION ENGAGED IN THE WORK OF MAINTAINING, SERVICING, OR REFAIRING ANY KIND—OF EXISTING PLUMBING INSTAILATION.
