(G) IN WICOMICO COUNTY, AS OF JULY 1, 1977, THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT THREE PERSONS, SUBJECT TO THE AFPROVAL OF THE SENATE, WHO WILL CONSTITUTE THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS FOR WICCMICO COUNTY. ONE COMMISSIONER SHALL BE AFPGINTED FOR A TERM OF COME YEAR; CNE SHALL BE APPOINTED FOR A TERM OF TWO YEARS; CNE SHALL BE APPOINTED FOR A TERM OF THE YEARS. (o) (1) The board of license commissioners of Wicomico County shall appoint an inspector. His salary shall be as provided in the county hudget from time to time. The duties of the inspector shall be as specified by the board of license commissioners and be for the proper administration and enforcement of the alcoholic beverage laws in Wicomico County. For the purposes of the alcoholic beverages laws, the inspector shall have all the powers of a peace officer or sheriff of the State
