Article 77 - Public Education

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 83(a) of Article 77 - Public Education, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1975 Replacement Volume and 1976 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 77 - Public Education

83.

(a) Any person who (1) has not obtained a high school certificate or diploma, [and who] (2) has resided in Maryland or on a federal reservation within the State of Maryland for at least three months, [and who] (3) is [17] 16 years of age or older, and (4) has withdrawn from a regular full-time public or private school program ~~[-for at least three months-]~~, may obtain a diploma by examination in accordance with this section. The State Board of Education may waive the [age and/or] residence requirements of this section[,] if [they deem such] IT CONSIDERS A waiver justified.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.
