in such form as may be prescribed by rule of the Superintendent.

(a) Salaries, expenses, and other costs incident to the operation of the Department and the performance of its duties, in such amount as is established by the budget, shall be disbursed in the manner prescribed by law. The source of such funds shall be determined in accordance with [Article 66 1/2, § 341] §12-118 OF THE TRANSFORTATION ARTICLE, or as otherwise provided by law.
