(G) "GUARDIAN" MEANS A GUARDIAN OF AN ESTATE APPOINTED BY A COURT UNDER SUBTITLE 2 OF THIS TITLE TO MANAGE THE PROPERTY OF A DISABLED PERSON OR MINOR OR A GUARDIAN OF A PERSON APPOINTED BY A COURT UNDER SUBTITLE 7 OF THIS TITLE, ACCORDING TO THE CONTEXT IN WHICH IT IS USED.

[ (f) ] (H) "Heirs" denotes those persons entitled under the laws of Maryland to the property of a protected person, as if he had died intestate at the applicable time.

(I) "INTERESTED PERSON" MEANS THE GUARDIAN, THE HEIRS OF THE MINOR OR DISABLED PERSON, ANY GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY PAYING BENEFITS TO THE MINOR OR DISABLED PERSON, OR ANY PERSON OR AGENCY ELIGIBLE TO SERVE AS GUARDIAN OF THE DISABLED PERSON UNDER SECTION 13-707 OF THIS SUBTITLE. IF AN INTERESTED PERSON IS ALSO A MINOR OR A DISABLED PERSON, INTERESTED PERSON ALSO INCLUDES A JUDICIALLY APPOINTED GUARDIAN, COMMITTEE, CONSERVATOR, OR TRUSTEE FOR THAT PERSON, OR, IF NONE, THE PARENT OR OTHER PERSON HAVING ASSUMED RESPONSIBILITY FOR HIM.

[ (h) ] (J) "Maryland Rules" is defined in § 1-101(m) of this article.

[ (k) ] A "protective proceeding" is a proceeding in accordance with Subtitle 2 of this title. ]

(K) "MENTAL FACILITY" MEANS ANY PLACE PROVIDING A CLINIC, HOSPITAL, DAY RESIDENTIAL OR OTHER PROGRAMS, PUBLIC OR PRIVATE, OTHER THAN A VETERANS' HOSPITAL, WHICH PURSUITS TO OR DOES PROVIDE TREATMENT FOR PERSONS SUFFERING FROM MENTAL DISORDERS AS DEFINED IN ARTICLE 59 § 3(F), MENTAL RETARDATION AS DEFINED IN ARTICLE 59A § 3(I), CHRONIC ALCOHOLISM AS DEFINED IN ARTICLE 2C § 103(B) AND DRUG ADDICTION AS DEFINED IN ARTICLE 43B § 3(F).

[ (i) ] ~~(K)~~ (L) A "minor" is a person who has not reached the age of 18.
