THE REGISTRATION RENEWAL STATEMENT SHALL BE IN THE FORM AND CONTENT PRESCRIBED BY THE COMMISSIONER, AND SHALL BE ACCOMPANIED BY A PROPOSED OFFERING PROSPECTUS. EACH REGISTRATION RENEWAL STATEMENT SHALL BE ACCOMPANIED BY THE FEE PRESCRIBED BY ~~THE COMMISSIONER~~ SECTION 328 (2).

A FRANCHISOR SHALL PROMPTLY NOTIFY THE COMMISSIONER IN WRITING, BY AN APPLICATION TO AMEND THE REGISTRATION, OF ANY MATERIAL CHANGE IN THE INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THE APPLICATION AS ORIGINALLY SUBMITTED, AMENDED OR RENEWED. THE COMMISSIONER BY RULE OR REGULATION MAY DEFINE FURTHER WHAT IS CONSIDERED A MATERIAL CHANGE FOR THESE PURPOSES, AND THE CIRCUMSTANCES UNDER WHICH A REVISED OFFERING PROSPECTUS SHALL ACCOMPANY THE APPLICATION.

AN AMENDMENT TO AN APPLICATION FILED AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE REGISTRATION OF THE SALE OF FRANCHISES, IF THE AMENDMENT IS APPROVED BY THE COMMISSIONER, SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE ON THE DATE THE COMMISSIONER MAY DETERMINE, HAVING DUE REGARD FOR THE PUBLIC INTEREST AND THE PROTECTION OF FRANCHISEES.

WHENEVER IT APPEARS TO THE COMMISSIONER THAT ANY PERSON HAS ENGAGED OR IS ABOUT TO ENGAGE IN ANY ACT OR PRACTICE, CONSTITUTING A VIOLATION OF ANY PROVISION OF THIS LAW OR ANY RULE OR ORDER UNDER IT, HE MAY BRING AN ACTION IN THE NAME OF THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND IN THE CIRCUIT COURT TO ENJOIN THE ACTS OR PRACTICES OR TO ENFORCE COMPLIANCE WITH THIS LAW OR ANY RULE OR ORDER UNDER IT. UPON A PROPER SHOWING, A PERMANENT OR PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION, RESTRAINING ORDER OR WRIT OR MANDATE SHALL BE GRANTED AND A RECEIVER OR CONSERVATOR MAY BE APPOINTED FOR THE DEFENDANT OR THE DEFENDANT'S
