

CHAPTER 774

(House Bill 500)

AN ACT concerning

Osteopathy

FOR the purpose of changing certain educational requirements for licensure as an osteopath and appointment to the Board of Osteopathic Examiners, the subjects required to be included in certain licensure examinations, ~~and the amount of certain fees~~; redefining the practice of osteopathy; deleting certain obsolete provisions relating to the original appointees to the Board and original licensees; and making style changes.
