- $\mbox{\ensuremath{\mbox{\sc i}}}(3)$](2) For domestic service in a private home, local college club or local chapter of a college fraternity or sorority.
- (4) J(3) For services performed by a duly ordained, commissioned, or a licensed minister of a church in the exercise of his ministry, or by a member of a religious order in the exercise of duties required by such order.
- [(5) For active service as a member of the National Guard or other duly established federal military reserve organizations.]
- (4) [Nonresident] FOR NONRESIDENT individuals employed as seamen or seawomen upon vessels engaged in cceanic and foreign trade or commerce while such vessels are within any of the ports of this State.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.

CHAPTER 798

(House Bill 1056)

AN ACT concerning

Maryland Physician Assistant — <u>Nurse Practitioner</u> Training Program

FOR the purpose of establishing the Maryland Physician Assistant — Nurse Practitioner Training Program to support certain training programs; establishing a formula for the granting of aid in this program; requiring the Maryland State Scholarship Board to establish rules and regulations for administration of the program; and providing for the reversion of unused funds.

BY adding to

Article 77A - Higher Education Section 61B Annotated Code of Maryland (1975 Replacement Volume and 1976 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That new Section 61B be and it is hereby added to Article 77A — Higher Education, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1975 Replacement Volume and 1976 Supplement)
