(A) AN EMPLOYEE OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND MAY NOT RECEIVE OR SOLICIT ANY REMUNERATION EITHER DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY FOR PROVIDING SERVICES ON BEHALF OF ANY MENTALLY RETARDED PERSON IN A PUBLIC FACILITY WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE ADMINISTRATION EXCEPT FOR COMPENSATION PROVIDED FOR IN THE BUDGET, THOSE CHARGES PROVIDED FOR IN THIS ARTICLE AND FUNDS RECEIVED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.

(B) A PUBLIC FACILITY WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE ADMINISTRATION MAY NOT ONLY ACCEPT NONBUDGETED FUNDS PURSUANT TO THE POLICY OR REGULATIONS ESTABLISHED BY THE SECRETARY FOR ACCEPTING AND EXPENDING NONBUDGETED FUNDS.

(C) A PERSON WHO KNOWINGLY VIOLATES THIS SUBSECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND UPON CONVICTION SHALL BE FINED AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$100 FOR EACH VIOLATION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.
