SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 4-734(a) (8) of Article - Natural Resources, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1974 Volume and 1976 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article - Natural Resources

4-734.

- (a) A person may not catch, sell, offer to buy or sell, expose for sale, or possess any of the following fish:
- (8) Striped cass, fless-MORE-than-f12] 32
 LESS THAN 12 inches in length [or weighing more than 15 rounds] OR MEASURING MORE THAN 32 INCHES. However, a person may catch one striped cass over 45-peunds 32 INCHES per day with hook and line in the tidal waters of the State at any time of the year except from March 1 to April 30 inclusive, which may not be sold or offered for sale.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.

AN ACT concerning

Architectural and Engineering Services - Notice of Waiver of Requirements for Procurement on a Competitive Basis
