SECTION 3. AND BE II FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2-30 9(b) (2) of Article - Transportation, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (As enacted by Chapter 13 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1977) be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

(b) (2) Each waiver and the reasons for it shall be:

(I) <u>documented</u> and reported to the <u>Legislative Policy Committee within 30 days; AND</u>

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. That Section 544(a)(1) of Article 48A -
