

(I) EACH CONTRACT COSTING OVER \$10,000 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, OR IMPROVEMENT OF ANY TRANSIT FACILITY; AND

(II) EACH CONTRACT COSTING OVER \$5,000 FOR THE PURCHASE OF SUPPLIES, EQUIPMENT, AND MATERIALS.

(2) FOR THESE CONTRACTS, A NOTICE REQUESTING BIDS SHALL BE PUBLISHED:

(I) IN A MANNER REASONABLY LIKELY TO ATTRACT PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS;

(II) AT LEAST 10 DAYS BEFORE THE BIDS ARE TO BE RECEIVED; AND

(III) IN AT LEAST TWO NEWSPAPERS OF GENERAL CIRCULATION IN THE DISTRICT.

(3) IN ITS DISCRETION, THE ADMINISTRATION MAY REJECT ALL BIDS AND REALVERTISE.

(C) SPECIAL RULES FOR CERTAIN PURCHASE CONTRACTS.

(1) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES ONLY TO ADVERTISED CONTRACTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF SUPPLIES, EQUIPMENT, OR MATERIALS.

(2) IF, AFTER REJECTING BIDS, THE ADMINISTRATION DETERMINES THAT, IN ITS OPINION, THE SUPPLIES, EQUIPMENT, OR MATERIALS CAN BE PURCHASED AT A LOWER PRICE IN THE OPEN MARKET, THE ADMINISTRATION, WITHOUT FURTHER OBSERVING THE PROVISIONS REQUIRING BIDS OR NOTICE, MAY:

(I) GIVE EACH RESPONSIBLE BIDDER AN OPPORTUNITY TO NEGOTIATE A PRICE; AND

(II) PURCHASE THE SUPPLIES, EQUIPMENT, OR MATERIALS IN THE OPEN MARKET AT A NEGOTIATED PRICE THAT IS LOWER THAN THE LOWEST REJECTED BID OF A RESPONSIBLE BIDDER.

(D) RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR OTHER PURCHASES OR CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS.

THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS TO PROVIDE FOR CONTRACTING WITH OR PURCHASING FROM THE LOWEST RESPONSIBLE BIDDER WHEN SEALED BIDS, NOTICE, AND PUBLICATION ARE NOT REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION.

(E) WAIVER OF REQUIREMENTS FOR COMPETITIVE BIDS.

THE ADMINISTRATION MAY WAIVE THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION REQUIRING COMPETITIVE BIDS IF:

(1) THE PURCHASE IS TO BE MADE FROM OR THE CONTRACT IS TO BE MADE WITH THE FEDERAL OR ANY STATE
