(House Bill 1347)

AN ACT concerning

Creation of a State Debt - Carcline County Jail

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of \$250,000, the proceeds to be used for the renovation, rehabilitation, and equipping of the Caroline County Jail, subject to the requirement that Caroline County provide at least an equal and matching sum for the same purpose; and providing generally for the issue and sale of bonds evidencing the lcan.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMELY OF MARYLAND. That:

The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Caroline County Jail Lcan of 1977 in the aggregate principal amount of \$250,000. This loan shall be evidences by the issuance and sale of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold and delivered in accordance with the provisions of §§ 19 to 23 of Article 31 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1971 Replacement Volume and 1975 Supplement, as amended from time to time).

The bonds issued to evidence this loan installments thereof may be sold as a single issue, or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bends under & 2B of Article 31 of the Code.

- The actual cash proceeds of the sale of the bends shall be paid to the Treasurer and shall be first applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing and delivering the bonds unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided and thereafter shall be credited on books of the State Comptroller and expended, upon approval by the Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable architects' and engineers' fees to assist in the renovations, rehabilitation, and equipping of the Caroline County Jail.
- The payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the purpose of providing a State grant to assist in the rehabilitation, renovation, and equipping of the Caroline County Jail shall be contingent upon the provisions by Caroline County of at least an equal and matching fund for this project from county funds. Board of County Commissioners of Baltimere Caroline Ccunty shall have until June 1, 1979 to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that it will provide at least an equal and matching fund for the
