1978. The Board of County Commissioners and the Board of Supervisors of Elections of Somerset County shall do those things necessary and proper to provide for and hold the referendum here required. There shall be printed on the ballots or ballot lakels to be used at this election the title of this Act and underneath the title, on separate lines, a square or box to the right of and opposite the words: "For Elected School Board" and a corresponding square or box to the right of and opposite the words "Against Elected School Board" so that each voter of the county may designate his or her decision for or against the provisions of this Act. If a majority the votes cast in the election are "For Flected School Board" the provisions of this Act shall become effective cn July 1, 1980, but if a majority of the votes cast in the election are "Against Elected School Board" the provisions of this Act shall be of no effect and null and void.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.
