to a credit shall be given a notice of the credit at the time the tax bill is sent to him. He may apply for the credit at any time up to October 1 of the taxable year, but if he has not made application on or before this date, the credit shall not be allowed. Application shall be made under oath or affirmation.

(e) In Baltimore County, [real and tangible personal property owned by the Gunrcuder Youth Camps, Inc., when used exclusively as a nonprofit youth camp and] real property owned by the Harford Park Improvement Association of Baltimore County, Inc.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.
