SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That new Section 36-19A be and it is hereby added to the Public Local Laws of Washington County being Article 22 of the Public Local Laws of Maryland (1970 Edition and 1975 Supplement, as amended) to read as follows:

Article 22

36-19A.

(A) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHINGTON COUNTY MAY AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY TREASURER TO ARRANGE WITH COMMERCIAL BANKS AND SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATIONS TO COLLECT STATE AND COUNTY REAL ESTATE AND PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES ON BEHALF OF THE TREASURER. THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY REQUIRE THAT A RESPONSIBLE OFFICIAL OF A COMMERCIAL BANK OR A SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, WHICH ARRANGES TO COLLECT TAXES UNDER THIS SECTION, GIVE BOND IN AMOUNT AND FORM AS PROVIDED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

(B) ARRANGEMENTS WITH COMMERCIAL BANKS AND SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATIONS TO COLLECT TAXES PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION SHALL BE SUBJECT TO ANY ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS WHICH THE COUNTY TREASURER CONSIDERS APPROPRIATE, INCLUDING ACCOUNTING, ISSUANCE OF RECEIPTS, REMITTANCE, AND COMMISSIONS.

(C) UPON THE PAYMENT OF ANY STATE OR COUNTY REAL ESTATE OR PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES TO A COMMERCIAL BANK OR A SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION AUTHORIZED UNDER THIS SECTION TO ACCEPT TAXES, THE TAXES DUE TO THE STATE OR COUNTY ARE PAID.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.
