to be a resident at the time of filing the application for a certain license; prohibiting the issuance of an alcoholic beverage license within a certain distance of private and parochial schools and allowing an exception for certain existing licenses; altering the physical area around a licensed establishment for which certain protests may prevent the renewal of a license; requiring the revocation of a license for certain activities; permitting the sale of alcoholic beverages on the day of any election in Harford County; altering certain requirements regarding the minimum age of employees in licensed establishments; permitting the maintenance of a county liquor dispensary within the first election district; clarifying language and structure; and making this act an emergency measure.
