- (8) Provide for the execution of surety bonds for every employee or officer entrusted with funds or property; [and]
- (9) Keep a full and accurate record of all proceedings and every rule or regulation or order issued or adopted[.]; AND
- (10) ASSIGN TO THE DISTRICTS SUCH CLERICAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE EMPLOYEES AS AUTHORIZED BY THE ANNUAL STATE BUDGET OR THROUGH AGREEMENT WITH IOCAL GOVERNMENTS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That new Section 9-0 be and it is hereby added to Article 64A - Merit System, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1972 Replacement Volume and 1976 Supplement) to read as follows:

Article 64A - Merit System

- DISTRICT, ANY SOIL CONSERVATION (A) CCNCURRENCE OF THE STATE SOIL CONSERVATION COMMITTEE AND UFON APPLICATION TO THE SECRETARY OF PERSONNEL PRIOR TO JULY 1, 4978 1979, MAY HAVE ALL OF ITS CLERICAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE EMPLOYEES WHO ARE CUFRENTLY SUFFCRTED BY STATE FUNDS AND WHO WERE EMPLOYED ON JUNE 30, 4977 1978 AND WHO ARE OTHERWISE ELIGIBLE, APPCINTED UNDER THE STATE MERIT SYSTEM AS EMPLOYEES OF THE STATE SOIL CONSERVATION COMMITTEE ASSIGNED TO THE DISTRICT. ANY EMPLOYEE AFPOINTED TO THE STATE MERIT SYSTEM PURSUANT SECTION SHALL BE APPOINTED WITHOUT FURTHER EXAMINATION OR QUALIFICATION. EACH EMPLOYEE SHALL BE PLACED IN THAT CLASSIFICATION WHICH IS COMPARABLE TO, OR MOST CLOSELY CCMPARES WITH, THE EMPLOYEE'S FORMER POSITION IN DUTIES RESPONSIBILITIES. AND
- EMPLOYEES SO APPOINTED PURSUANT TO (B) SECTION MAY NOT SUFFER A DIMINUTION OF SALARY OF WAGES, ACCRUED PAID LEAVE WHETHER EARNED OF GRANTED, OR ANY INCREASE IN SALARY OR WAGES SENIORITY RIGHTS. GRANTED SUBSEQUENT TO DECEMBER 31, 4976 1977, MAY BE RETAINED UPON APPOINTMENT TO THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE ONLY IF APPROVED BY THE SECRETARY OF PERSONNEL. THE SECRETARY CF PERSONNEL SHALL CONSIDER THE MCNETARY VALUE OF ANY AND ALL OTHER BENEFITS, ENTITLEMENTS, SERVICES OR PREROGATIVES AND, AT HIS DISCRETION AND IN CONSIDERATION OF THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE MAY VALUES OR ANY PERTICN THEREOF INTO CONSIDERATION WHEN ESTABLISHING THE RATE OF SALARY UPON AFFOINIMENT. ONCE THE RATE OF SALARY HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED UPON APPOINTMENT, THE EMPLOYFE SHALL BE ENTITLED TO THE SAME BENEFITS PROVIDED TO CLASSIFIED EMPLOYEES ESTABLISHED BY ARTICLE 64A OF THE CODE. FUNDING FOR THESE POSITIONS MAY BE ON A COST SHARING ARRANGEMENT WITH LCCAL GOVERNMENTS.
 - (C) PERSONNEL WHO ARE EMPLOYED ON OR AFTER JULY 1,
