CHAPTER 876

(Senate Bill 185)

AN ACT concerning

State Highway Administration - Sale of Land

FOR the purpose of changing the authority of the State Highway Administration to dispose of land no longer required for highway use; providing for withdrawal of land from sale under certain circumstances; ~~correcting certain references to the Administration;~~ and generally relating to its authority to dispose of land.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

SECTION 1. ~~[1] (A) It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that the State [Roads Commission] HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION should divest itself from ownership of land not needed for current or future highway purposes or other public purposes in order that [such] THE land can be placed back on the tax records of the several counties and be used for residential development or be otherwise developed by private~~
