- (2) PROVIDE THAT INCIVIDUALS ELIGIBLE FOR ADMISSION TO THE SYSTEM ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR ADMISSION TO OR BLIGIBLE TO RECEIVE ANY BENEFITS FROM ANY OTHER PENSION SYSTEM, EXCEPT SOCIAL SECUBITY BENEFITS, IF THE OTHER SYSTEM IS FINANCED OR FUNDED, WHETHER WHOLLY OR PARTIALLY OR DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY, BY FUNDS PAID OR APPROPRIATED BY THE ADMINISTRATION; AND
- (3) PROVIDE A SYSTEM OF BENEFITS PAYABLE TO THE BENEFICIARIES AND DEPENDENTS OF ANY PARTICIPANT IN THE SYSTEM AFTER THE DEATH OF THE PARTICIPANT, WHETHER ACCIDENTAL OR NOT AND WHETHER OCCURRING IN THE FERFORMANCE OF DUTY OR NOT, SUBJECT TO ANY EXCEPTIONS, CONDITIONS, RESTRICTIONS, AND CLASSIFICATIONS THAT THE ADMINISTRATION PROVIDES.
 - (C) DUAL BENEFITS RESTRICTED.

UNLESS THE ADMINISTRATION DETERMINES OTHERWISE, NO EMPLOYEE OF THE ADMINISTRATION AND NO BENEFICIARY OR DEPENDENT OF ANY EMPLOYEE OF THE ADMINISTRATION IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE ANY PENSION, RETIREMENT, OR OTHER BENEFIT BOTH UNDER THE ADMINISTRATION'S SYSTEM AND UNDER ANY OTHER PENSION OR RETIREMENT SYSTEM ESTABLISHED BY AN ACQUIRED TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM OR FROVIDED FOR UNDER ANY COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE ADMINISTRATION AND THE AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVES OF ITS EMPLOYEES.

(D) FINANCING OF PENSION SYSTEM.

THE PENSION SYSTEM SHALL BE FINANCED OR FUNDED AS THE ADMINISTRATION DETERMINES ECONOMICALLY FEASIBLE.

- 7-604. COMPENSATION OF LABORERS AND MECHANICS.
 - (A) ADMINISTRATION TO ENSURE ADEQUATE COMPENSATION.

THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL TAKE THE ACTION NECESSARY TO ENSURE THAT EVERY LABORER AND MECHANIC EMPLOYED BY CONTRACTORS OR SUBCONTRACTORS IN THE CONSTRUCTION, ALTERATION, OR REPAIR, INCLUDING PAINTING AND DECORATING, OF PROJECTS, BUILDINGS, AND WORKS UNDERTAKEN OR FINANCIALLY ASSISTED BY THE ADMINISTRATION:

(1) IS PAID WAGES AT RATES NOT LESS THAN
