

AND RENDER A DECISION ON APPEALS ANY APPEAL WITHIN 45 60 DAYS OF RECEIPT OF THE APPEAL.

(2) THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION SHALL HEAR AND RENDER A DECISION ON APPEALS WITHIN 45 ANY APPEAL WITHIN 60 DAYS OF RECEIPT OF THE APPEAL.

(3) IF THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION DOES NOT COMPLY WITH (2), THE CIRCUIT COURT OF MARYLAND, UPON PETITION, SHALL HEAR AND RENDER A DECISION ON THE APPEAL WITHIN 45 DAYS AFTER RECEIPT OF THE PETITION AS SOON AFTER TRANSMISSION OF THE RECORD AS MAY BE PRACTICABLE. THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION SHALL COMPLY WITH THE RULING OF THE CIRCUIT COURT WHICH RULING SHALL BE ENFORCEABLE BY THE COURT AND SUBJECT ONLY TO THE MARYLAND RULES OF PROCEDURE AND TO THE PROVISIONS OF §106D(G) OF THIS ARTICLE.

(4) THE TIME LIMITATIONS IMPOSED IN SUBPARAGRAPHS (1) AND (2) SHALL BE EXTENDED OR WAIVED UPON WRITTEN REQUEST OF THE APPELLANT MADE TO THE BODY CONDUCTING THE APPEAL.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.

#### CHAPTER 887

(Senate Bill 377)

AN ACT concerning

Calvert County - Pension

FOR the purpose of providing a certain pension for any surviving spouse of a certain former Treasurer of Calvert County; and relating generally to the pension and the conditions upon which it shall be paid.
