authority of this section for any State fiscal year may not exceed [0.15] 0-20 0-16 0.17 percent of the public service company's gross operating revenues derived from intrastate utility operations in the last preceding calendar year, or other twelve-month period as determined by the chairman FOR THE OPERATIONS OF THE COMMISSION OTHER THAN THAT OF THE OFFICE OF PECPLE'S COUNSEL PLUS A MAXIMUM OF 0-04 0.03 PERCENT OF THESE BEVENUES FOR THE OPERATIONS OF THE OFFICE OF THE PEOPLE'S COUNSEL.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.
