[(d) In Montgomery County from July 1, 1976, all unpaid taxes on personal property are a lien on the real property of the delinquent taxpayer in the same manner in which taxes on real property are now liens on the real property with respect to which they are levied, provided that the real property is situated in Montgomery County and that the lien will attach to the real property only after notice thereof has been duly recorded and indexed among the judgment records in the office of the clerk of the Circuit Court for Montgomery County.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Chapters 878, 879, 880, 881, 882, 883, 884, and 885 of the Laws of Maryland of 1976 be and they are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.
